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PHONETIC ALPHABET for Spelling

SPELLING ALPHABET	
A for ALPHA or Apple	N for NOVEMBER or Nelly
B for BRAVO or Brazil	O for OSCAR
C for CHARLIE or CAT	P for PETER
D for DELTA or DOG	Q for QUEBEC (kwhe-bek)
E for ECHO (eh-kou)	R for ROMEO
F for FOXTROT	S for SIERRA
G for GOLF	T for TANGO
H for HOTEL	U for UNIFORM (yu-niform)
I for INDIA	V for VICTORIA
J for JULIETTE or Jelly	W for WHISKEY
K for KILO	X for X- RAY (eks-rey)
L for LIMA or Lenny	Y for YANKEE
M for MIKE or Miami	Z for ZULU

Two Exercises for you to practice

1. SPELL YOUR NAME USING THE PHONETIC ALPHABET ABOVE.

For example: My name is Anna. A for Alpha, N for November, N for November, A for Alpha.

If this is hard to pronounce, try different words: A for Apple, N for Nelly, N for Nelly, A for Apple.
